

## 1. H & S STATEMENT

- Adequate information is available with respect to articles and substances used at work detailing the conditions and precautions necessary to ensure that when properly used they will be safe and without risks to health.
- The provision of such information, instruction, training, and supervision as is necessary, to secure the Health and Safety at work of all employees.
- The maintenance of all plant, machinery, and equipment at any premises or operations under our controls are safe to employees, contractors, and any other persons who may be affected.
- The working environment of all employees is safe and without risks to health, and adequate provisions made regarding the facilities and arrangements for their welfare at work.
- The Health and Safety Policy is appraised and updated based on the principles as defined within the EHS Frame of Reference document, following changes in legislation, or working practices. Communication of any such changes will be made to all employees.
- The company actively encourages feedback from all employees at all levels on matters relating to Health Safety and Welfare within the workplace.
